

WAYS TO MEASURE YOUR RING SIZE

The size that is chosen is also affected by the specific ring. Wider rings will require larger sizes than thinner rings, even for the same finger. Often, the BEST way to determine ring size is to go to a jeweller for a fitting and remember which country unit the jeweller is using (eg- Japan sizing, UK sizing, US sizing etc..)

So here's possible ways to help 'ESTIMATE' the ring size that you need.

- ① Measure your finger by wrapping a string around it. Find the length of the string that makes exactly one loop around, and use the chart below for reference.

- ② If you have an existing ring, you can use a ruler to measure its diameter.
